

Alt (alternative) text is a simple description of an image that can be read by screen-reading software. It's best to keep the description short and concise: screen readers generally only read about 125 characters for alt text.

Read your alt text aloud in the context of the document to make sure it has the same impact as the image

Mark unimportant images and backgrounds as decorative. This will tell a screen reader to ignore them.

There's no need to write "Image of..." or "Picture of..." – a screen reader will do this automatically


