



**Prioritise people with disabilities and other marginalised groups from the design stage of your next activity.**



**Incorporate disability inclusion indicators within monitoring and evaluation plans.**



**Collect, analyse, use and disseminate data disaggregated by disability.**



**Conduct a research study on the barriers experienced by a specific disability constituency, such as people with psychosocial disabilities.**



Conduct a research study aimed at demonstrating the effectiveness of targeted disability inclusive approaches.



Appoint a disability inclusion focal point or committee within the team or department.



Organise disability inclusion training for your team.



Organise disability inclusion training for your partners.



**Establish partnerships and alliances with organisations of people with disabilities**



**Recruit people with disabilities within the team.**



**Provide reasonable accommodations to people with disabilities working in the team.**



**Support the development of inclusive and accessible digital health services.**



Support the development of disability-inclusive safeguarding policies and processes.



Promote free and informed consent and bodily autonomy for people with disabilities.



Collect and disseminate case studies of disability inclusion champions.



Collect and disseminate stories of people with disabilities accessing healthcare.



**Sensitise the broader population on the importance of health equity, fighting stigma and discrimination against people with disabilities.**



**Create synergies with other government departments to ensure a cross-sectoral approach towards health equity for people with disabilities.**



**Make all communication materials accessible for people with different impairments**



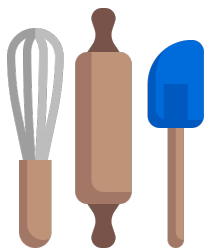
**Incorporate positive images of people with disabilities in all their diversity in all communication materials.**



**Conduct accessibility audits of health facilities.**

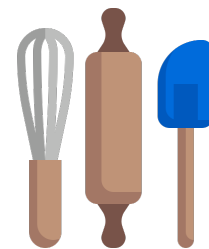


**Renovate health facilities to make them more accessible.**



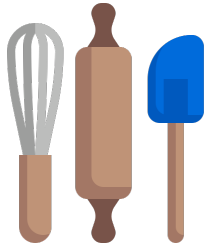
